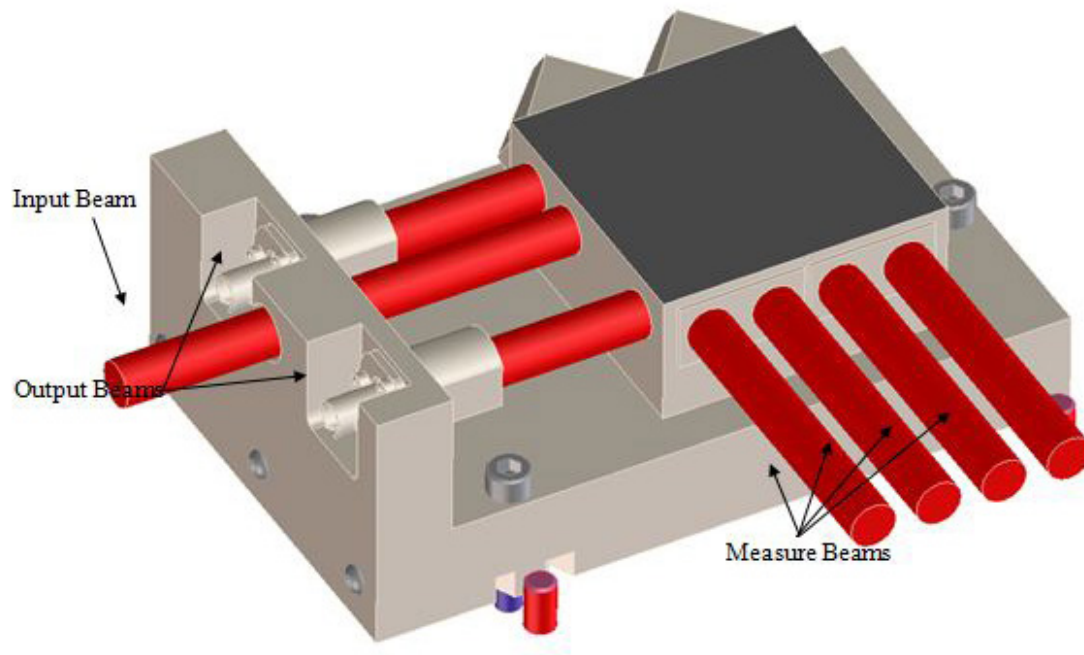

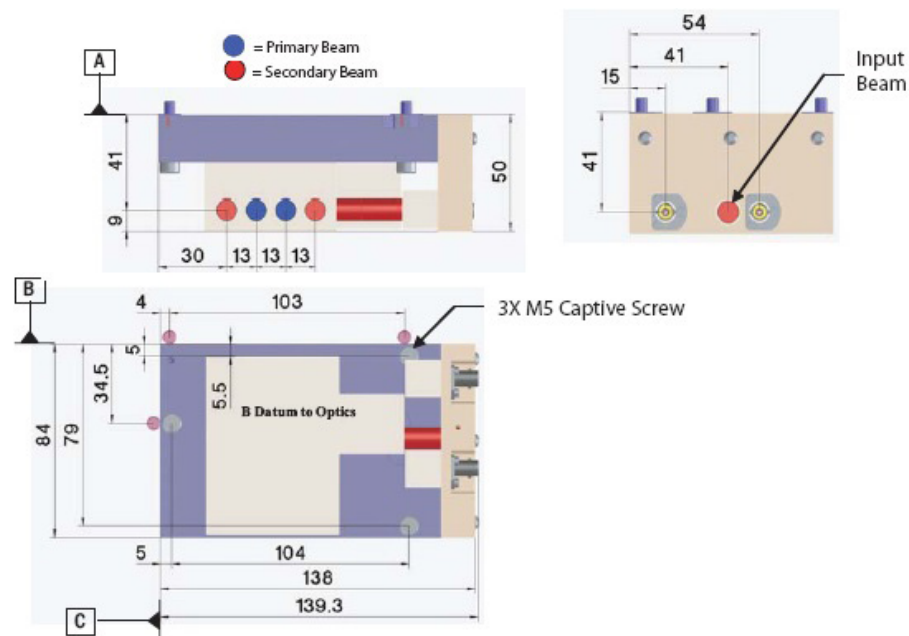
E1827A 2-axis Interferometer showing input and output beams

Key features
