## Keysight Technologies Statement on Extended Minerals Sourcing

Keysight Technologies is committed to conducting business in a responsible, ethical, and sustainable manner. As part of this commitment, Keysight expects its suppliers to source minerals responsibly and to respect internationally recognized human rights and labor standards throughout their supply chains.

Certain minerals used in electronic products present heightened risks of adverse environmental, social, or human rights impacts, particularly when sourced from conflict-affected or high-risk areas. These minerals include cobalt, mica, copper, lithium, nickel, natural graphite, and other minerals that may be identified over time as presenting similar risks.

Keysight aligns its responsible minerals sourcing expectations with recognized industry initiatives, including the [Responsible Minerals Initiative](#) (RMI), and expects suppliers to support transparency and responsible practices within their own supply chains.

Keysight does not knowingly support the use of minerals associated with armed conflict or serious human rights abuses, including forced labor or child labor. Responsible minerals sourcing forms part of Keysight's broader [Corporate Social Responsibility](#) program and reflects its commitment to ethical business conduct and sustainable supply-chain management.
